<b>Registan Ensemble</b>	<p>Registan is the center of Samarkand. The spectacular, the magnificent, the heart of Samarkand these are just the few words that describe this monument. Registan stands not only for its beauty but it was of the centers of science, literature, arts in Samarkand.</p>	
<b>Gur-Amir Mausoleum</b>	<p>Gur - Amir Mausoleum is one the most beautiful monuments in Samarkand. Was built by Amir Timur after the sudden death of Muhammad Sultan Tamerlane's heir. It is famous for its simplicity of construction and fluted dome. Later the mausoleum became the family crypt for Timur's dynasty.</p>	
<b>Ulugbek Observatory</b>	<p>Ulugbek's observatory is considered by scholars one of the finest observatories in the Islamic world. It became an important center for astronomical study and at its peak had between 60 and 70 astronomers working there. Discoveries and research conducted at Ulug Bek's Observatory were very important at the time as astronomers could predict eclipses and calculate the hour of the rising sun and altitude of a celestial body.</p>
